North Meade St. Parking Options

Arlington County provides several types of permits for weekday parking on N. Meade St. for RHE residents (whose vehicles are registered with the county) and their visitors. Generally, no parking restrictions apply on N. Meade St. (parking zone 5) outside of 8 am to 5 pm Monday-Friday.

Temporary Permits. The Arlington County application process for the permits listed below may take up to four weeks, the county says. Residents who have applied for permits and passes can obtain a temporary permit by contacting the Residential Permit Parking Program (email park@arlingtonva.us) or call 703-228-3344.

FlexPass is a dashboard placard that can be used in either an RHE resident’s or guest’s vehicle. The FlexPass is specific to the resident’s household and displays the zone number and household address. The FlexPass placard costs \$40/year. FlexPasses are renewed annually and issued once per fiscal year by Arlington County. For more information, call 703-228-3344.

Vehicle-Specific Permits adhere to the rear bumper of a resident’s vehicle; the vehicle must be registered in Arlington County. These permits are non-transferable and non-refundable. In general, each RHE household may have two vehicle-specific permits or one FlexPass and one vehicle-specific permit. The cost of the first vehicle-specific permit (or FlexPass) is \$40/year; cost of a second permit is \$55/year.

Short-Term Visitor Passes may be obtained by RHE residents to give to their guests (including vendors such as painters, plumbers, etc.), allowing them to park on N. Meade St. during the weekday. Short-Term Visitor Passes are placed face-up on the dashboard. Residents fill in the circles and write the dates for which the pass is effective. Each pass is valid for up to three consecutive days. Residents can apply to the county for one Short-Term Visitor Pass booklet (which contains 20 passes) for \$5, and up to four additional booklets for \$10.00 each.

NOTE: Pass and permit costs cited above are effective on or after July 1, 2021.
